Neighbourhood Alert: [Editor's comment] I was struck by an article in the Durham Police and Crime Commissioner's monthly update about a road safety campaign highlighting the fatal consequences of the 'Fatal Four' driving offences: mobile phone use, seatbelts, drink/drug driving and speeding. Family-run Katem Logistics Ltd, based in Bowburn, Durham, has offered its full support to the 'Life is Precious' campaign to raise awareness of the **deadly impact of using a handheld mobile phone while driving**. The 'Life is Precious' campaign was founded by Mari Johnson following the death of her mother, Elaine Sullivan, and stepfather, David Daglish, from Seaham, on the A1 (M) in 2021 after a lorry driver ploughed into their vehicle. Sadly, in villages we sometimes see drivers using mobile phones, often going around blind corners and sometimes also travelling too fast for the prevailing conditions and view. So: **DON'T DO IT!** If you do witness such behaviours, the non-emergency Police contact number is published above.

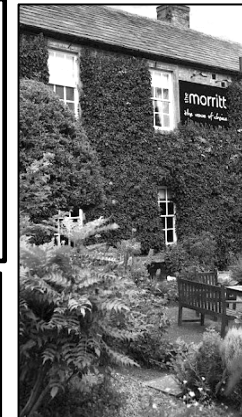

Sycamore Gap, Douglas Anderson

The country's most recognised natural nature scene – From seed to sapling, then full-grown tree, Survived nature's hazards and reached maturity. To lean on this tree trunk and look up through the branches in leaf or bare You could be under a tree canopy almost any where. This tree is neither beech, oak, ash nor spreading chestnut on some village green. Three centuries it has grown to become this exclusive scene

Where Hadrian's wall takes a downward plunge for a few Roman strides, Then climbs the hill again leaving a hollow, walled both sides.

Sheltered, healthy, growing, this sycamore silhouette fills the sky.

The dull, damp wind turns the leaves to their paler sides.

The single winged seeds from this tree in circles fly, Inspiring artists, film producers and tourists with cameras to snap

A picture of this sycamore gap.

No moon, no stars, the night pitch black, no wind no sound –

Two shapeless figures cross the dew damp ground. No wind, no sound –

A chain-saw engine breaks the silence then comes to a sudden stop.

A tearing sound, a loud crack, branches are breaking; the sycamore tree falls a heavy drop.

Daylight comes and what do we see – The destruction of this well-loved tree...
